- Using technology to make practices more efficient and profitable

We prefer articles to be written in Microsoft Word or compatible format. When you have written your article, email it to editor@ndnr.com for review and editing. We edit for style and space and to ensure it meets our editorial guidelines. We follow standard Associated Press (AP) style, similar to the way articles appear in most popular newspapers and magazines. We reserve the right to reject any article or photo. *We generally do not accept material that has been previously published in other media such as magazines, newspapers, newsletters and Web sites.*
